PAINTED HILLTOP FARM RIDING LESSON PROTOCOL – EFFECTIVE APRIL 19, 2021

Please note: The following protocols has been developed to comply with government regulations to promote social distancing standards. Changes to the protocol will be announced as regulations alter or restrictions are lifted.

- Social distancing measures are to be used by staff, riders, and essential family present while at Painted Hilltop Farm
- Wearing a mask is <u>mandatory at all times indoors and outside</u> when social distancing cannot be respected from another household for people 10 years of age and over. It is highly recommended for people from 2 to 10 years old but not mandatory.
- <u>Please wait in your car until your lesson time</u> to prevent overlapping with other clients.
- No more than 5 people may gather at the lesson including coach and student
- Stable access is not permitted unless instructed by staff
- Riders and guardians are expected to wash their hands prior to coming to the farm, and use the hand sanitizer provided when they arrive and leave
- All tack and brushes will be retrieved and sanitized by staff prior to lesson
- To allow social distancing, young riders who require assistance tacking up will have horses tacked up prior to lesson time. Parents will be required to help students mount and dismount.
- Lessons will be booked with 15-minute gaps in between to allow staff to clean school tack and brushes
- Our facility will be closed by 7pm to allow time to get home before curfew
